Acts 2:42-47

⁴²They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. ⁴³Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles. ⁴⁴All the believers were together and had everything in common. ⁴⁵They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need. ⁴⁶Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, ⁴⁷praising God and enjoying the favour of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

Pray for the congregation:

- Thank God that we have the apostolic gospel and teachings in the pages of the New Testament and ask we would be devoted to learning together (V.42, see also 2 Tim 1:13-14 and context)
- That we would be devoted to each other, deepening in relationships (v.42,44)
- That we would continue to pray together using this card, and the prayer walk card provided by the Outreach Team (v.42)
- That we would be committed to one another's needs as the early church (v.45)
- That God would add to our number by bringing people to saving faith in Jesus. (V.47)

Pray for the community:

- For the staff and pupils at the schools, that they would be helped even as they continue with a different way of learning
- For the vaccination programme to be rolled out effectively in our parish
- For those who are isolated and lonely, that God would show them his love in Christ and we that we would serve and love them

Pray for God's wider work: Highland Theological College UHI

- Give thanks that we have a quality Theological College in the Highlands, committed to being "a community of faith and scholarship"
- Give thanks that HTC has a lot of experience of "blended learning" (i.e. using online and other methods) which has stood them in good stead at the moment
- Pray that staff and students will continue to support one another and know God's help
